STEP LEADERSHIP TRAINING

February 8,9 & 16, 2003

Leadership training is a three-day workshop designed to train participants to successfully facilitate Adlerian and STEP parenting groups. Participants are introduced to the principles of Adlerian Psychology through a historical overview of the work of Alfred Adler and Rudolf Dreikurs. The introduction focuses on the influence of these teachings on contemporary family education and its relevance to today's issues. The training includes adult learning principles, group dynamics, communication and leadership skills, co-facilitation, and the "how to" of setting up and running parenting groups. The course format is lecture, group discussion, role playing, and the presentation of a model session. Upon course completion and after successfully leading a supervised Adlerian Parent Study Group, participants will receive certification of completion from APABC. Previous participation in an Adlerian Parenting Group is required unless you are a professional currently working with families.

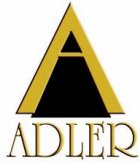
